## IN A SEWER ALL NIGHT

## THREE GERMANS OF FT. HENRY SPEND UNPLEASANT NIGHT

They Tried to Escape by Crawling Into Sewer, and the Commandant Left Them There.

Three prisoners at Fort Henry tried to escape on Monday afternoon, but are still safely inside the fort walls. The plan adopted by the trio was not quite as clever as they supposed, and Lieut.-Col, P. G. C. Campbell had not the slightest difficulty in finding their whereabouts.

Some men were working on the mouth of a tunnel or drain in the centre of the lower court of the camp. Three of the Germans looked upon this as a good way to escape. They eluded the guards and crawled into the hole and wandered a hundred feet along through the mud and slime, but the other end of the hole was solidly blocked.

The report of the escape reached the commandant, but instead of sending a search party, he decided that a night in their chosen place of hiding would do no harm. On Tuesday morning he sent a guard down to tell them to come out and in future to conduct themselves properly.
