Foreign Publications Banned From Canada

Ottawa, Dec. 22.—Die Abendschule, a fortnightly magazine published in German at St. Louis, Mo.; Biez Bozy, a Polish paper published in Milwaukee; Wettlicher Herald, Volksblatt des Westens and Sonntago Winona, all published at Winona, Minn.; Der Wanderer, published at St. Paul, Minn.; Narodna Wola, a Ruthenian paper published at Scranton, Pa.; The New York Freeman Journal, The Tagliche Abend Presse, and The Cincinnatier Freie Presse, published in Cincinnati, have all been forbidden the mails under the **war measures act**.
