

AND THEN THEY WERE DEPORTED

A dozen Greeks were carefully herded into the Sault a few days ago, and were found working at the Steel Plant, where there exist vacancies for hundreds of men. The men were rounded up by the Immigration officers, acting under orders, and shipped back to Michigan again. The officers were doing their duty, of course.

Only a little while ago the Government of Ontario spent \$10,000 in Michigan trying to get men to come to Canada. It got 200.

So far as is known, Greece is not at war with the Allies, and so far as we know Greeks are not prohibited as alien enemies.

The situation, therefore, is somewhat puzzling. The Dominion Government is so hard up for labor that this week it is asking all males in Canada between 16 and 65 to register. At the same time it ships out of this country a dozen men who are not enemies and who are perfectly willing to help Canada make munitions.

The government might very well investigate the matter and explain the puzzle to the public.
