

# Winnipeg Lutheran Is Called Disloyal

Officials of the Army and Navy Veterans have refused to accept an explanation by Rev. P. E. Baisler in answer to charges made by Lieut. S. P. Peterson, of the 197th Battalion, that the Winnipeg Lutheran is a disloyal publication.

Lieut. Peterson called the veterans' attention to two articles, captioned, "England's Outcast Population" and "Germany's Applied Democracy," which appeared in the publication, part of which is edited in Winnipeg.

Rev. Baisler explained that the articles complained of were book reviews in that section of the church paper printed in the United States. Winnipeg church news, he said, is printed in a special section of the paper.

Secretary Edward Low, of the Veterans, said today that German subtlety was evident in reading matter in the paper.
