Fernie, B.C., Jan. 21.-What may result in an unexpected change in the strike situation here became evident this afternoon whom at a regular meeting of the Fernie local union, upon receipt of further communications from the international and district headquarters, a special mass meeting has been called for tomorrow. This meeting is exclusively for the purpose of deciding whether the decision to remain idle will be adhered to or whether work should be resumed immediately. Indications toalght are that many of the men are now dissatistied with the previous strike decision and it is now being openly asserted that many realize nothing can be lost by continuing work during the final negatiations, and in fact their cause may be further sustained. Hellevue, Carbondale and Coleman will remain at work and be governed by orders of the executive. Blairmore, however, will be on strike tomorrow, as that decision was reached today. Frank will reconsider the question of remaining idle. With strikes at Hillcrest and Michel still on the situation remains unchanged

elsewhere.
