ALIENS QUIT MINES

Ten Men Ordered to Leave Work at Cumberland.

VICTORIA, Feb. 1.—Word was received by Hon. William Sloan, minister of mines, from Chief Mines Inspector Graham, who is now making a tour of the coal mines on the Island, that he had ordered out of the Cumberland mines 10 alien enemies who had been released from the internment camps by the military authorities and permitted to accept work in the mines.

Twelve were ejected also from the

Nanaimo coai mines. The aliens are being kept in charge of the provincial police until they can be returned to the internment camps.
