

DISCOVER PLOT TO KILL WILSON

Bombs Were to Be Sent to the President
By Huns.

THREE ARRESTS ARE MADE

ONE CONFESSED THAT WILSON
WAS MARKED.

Arrested in Room Full of Bombs and
High Explosives—Had Hand in
Blowing up Two Munition Plants.

Hoboken, N.J., March 6—A wholesale bomb plot, including a possible plan of attack on President Wilson, was believed to have been revealed here yesterday afternoon in the arrest of Fritz Kolb, a German reservist from Mexico, age 36, in a local hotel room, in which were found several bombs and quantities of explosives.

In Kolb's room, the police said, enough explosives were found to have destroyed the entire city. Articles for the manufacture of bombs and several of the completed missiles were discovered. Nitro-glycerine and picric acid were found in considerable quantities. No detonating caps were on the completed bombs.

Detectives said bombs were to have been sent to the President last night.

Upon information declared to have been given by Kolb, detectives arrested two other men, one here and one in Jersey City, and brought them to police headquarters as alleged accomplices.
