

Interned Aliens Are to be Moved From Fort Henry

Ottawa, March 20.— Arrangements are being completed for the immediate transfer of the enemy aliens interned at Fort Henry, Kingston, to the internment camp at Kapuskasing, in Northern Ontario.

Fort Henry is to be used for military purposes, and the prisoners can be more suitably looked after at the new camp, where they will have open air and healthful exercise in carrying on the work of clearing and cultivating land begun by the hundreds of Germans and Austrians who were sent there during the early months of the war. Most of these latter are now voluntarily employed under surveillance as laborers in various parts of the Dominion.

Several hundred of them have been sent to work in the coal and iron mines of Nova Scotia.
