

Henry Dosch was arrested

Monday 19, for trading with the enemy, by sending sums of money to Germany via the United States and Holland. Leo Weigerinck was arrested with Dosch, charged with assisting him in sending sums of money to Germany. These men were taken to Medicine Hat, Alta., where they appeared before

Inspector Sheesbotham, of the R.N.W.M.P. They were remanded until Thursday, March 22, that they might procure bail. Henry Dosch was released on bail of \$1000 and Leo Weigerinok on bail of \$1,000. Both men to appear at the R.N.W.M.P barracks on May 1st, 1917.
