

# VETERANS CONDUCT RAID IN TORONTO

## March Five Austrians Down to Agnes Street Station

Toronto, April 11.—In spite of the truce agreed to by the civic officials and representatives of the Great War Veterans association, returned soldiers to the number of 50 last night executed a raid on the factory of the Sheet Metal Products company, formerly the Kemp Manufacturing company, at River and Gerrard streets, and marched five Austrians to Agnes street station. The Austrians held the permission of the registrar of alien enemies to be at large and were at once released. The returned soldiers also visited several other munition plants. No violence was shown anywhere, and no damage done.
