Would Bar Aliens Voting Unless They Live Here 25 Years

TORONTO, May 1-By a majority of 17 to five the city council passed, after an animated debate, a resolution to petition the Dominion parliament to provide that only such naturalized natives of alien enemy countries as have lived in Canada for 25 years shall be allowed to exercise the franchise at any election in war time, or until otherwise provided, except such naturalized natives of alien enemy countries as are on active service themselves or have sons or daughters on active service in the Canadian expeditionary force or other branches of His Majesty's forces; secondly, to request the government "to arrange for the deportation after the war of all natives of enemy countries now in Canada who may use seditious language or express sympathy with the Germans in the war, and that the imigration laws be amended to prevent such people being again permitted to enter the country."
