## CONSERVATIVES WOULD BAR ALL ALIEN 'ENEMIES'

Manitoba Party Urges New Franchise Law In Case of Election

Manitoba Conservatives are arging the Dominion parliament to pass a new franchise act which will deny to all aliens born in enemy countries, whether naturalized or not, the right to vote in a general election, it was learned today.

At the recent provincial Conservalive convention, held in Winnipeg, June 21, a resolution to this effect was passed, though it was not given tiblicity at the time. The resolution, which has since been forwarded

to Ottawa, follows:

"Resolved, that this convention, desering only to take such action as will best give to the allies the benefit of the full force of Canada's power and resources, hereby advises:

"(1) The extension of the life of parliament without an appeal to the lectorate by way of a general elec-

"(2). That in case of a general election the Dominion parliament pass a new franchise act, and that the franchise be given to all persons, male or female, being British subjects who were born in Canada or in the British empire or its possessions, or of British parentage, or in allied or neutral countries, and to all Canadian soldiers.

"(3). That a copy of this resolution be sent to the members of the diouse of commons and to the senate, and to the Rt. Hon. Sir Robert Bor-

don."
