Voterans, Disgusted, Return From The Drumheller Mines

Calgary, Aug. 16.-Trouble is re-

ported at the Star Coal Mining camp

at Drumheller. A large number of miners, including Austrians, went on stilke yesterday afternoon and upon the arrival of seven veterans from Calgary, who were appointed temporary constables, they cut the telephone wires connecting with Calgary in an effort to prevent further communications between the constables and the city.

The seven veterans, disgusted with

the conditions, returned to Calgary today with the advice that a squad of soldiers be sent up there to suppress the incipient insurrection and to intern and force to work, the alien enemies, who were the majority of the men causing the trouble.

The trouble has arisen over the

question of the unionization of the

camp.
