

LA LUMIERE KEPT IN JAIL

Seditionist Formally Charged With Attempted Murder.

MONTREAL, Sept. 1.—Elie La Lumiere, who is now held by the register of alien enemies on a charge of having attempted to murder Lord and Lady Atholstan and their daughter, is not to be allowed his liberty now, even though he should want it. This morning Judge Monet dismissed the petition of a writ of habeas corpus asking for the release of La Lumiere on the ground that La Lumiere had been offered his freedom previous to the application for the writ, and had chosen, for reasons best known to himself, to remain in the custody of the authorities. The prisoner's assent was essential to support such a writ, his lordship said. Since La Lumiere was offered his liberty, however, a warrant has been issued, and he is now being held on this warrant.

Elie Also Arrested

Elie La Lumiere, head of the constitutionalists, an anti-conscription organization, also was arrested on a warrant charging attempted murder.
