## HAVE ALIEN ENEMIES DO NATIONAL LABOR?

TORONTO, Sept. 28.—"That this company do go on record as being in favor of the conscription of wealth and natural resources and that we believe the Government should put it into effect at an early date, with special emphasis on a real control of food resources," was the resolution carried unanimously at a meeting of company D of the G.W.V.A. organization here. Another motion read:

"That in all fairness to British eitizens, this company believes the citizens of allied nations, unless willing
to enlist, should be deported to their
respective countries, where they will
come under the conscription laws of

helr own nations."

"That all alien enemies should be excepated and utilized for necessary national labor, and that the said labor should be paid for at military rates for the duration of the war," was another motion endorsed by the veterans.
