

BURWASH INDUSTRIAL FARM INVESTIGATED

Toronto, Nov. 1.—Stories that prisoners were toiled to a steel machine and flogged, that the food and clothing were poor and conditions generally insanitary at the Burwash industrial farm, near Sudbury, have been personally investigated by Secretary McPherson, and a party of newspaper men and others. Mr. McPherson expressed surprise at some of the revelations, and said there was nothing which could not be remedied. He will take the necessary steps to do this.
