

GERMAN PRISONERS FOR CANADA'S FARMS

Government Has Under Consideration a Proposal to Import Hundred Thousand

Ottawa, Jan. 10—The Government has under consideration a proposal to bring to Canada German prisoners of war to work on the farms of the Dominion. About 100,000 of these are available, and the necessity for growing more food demands effective action. This available help might aid in solving the situation.

It is quite possible that in the near future there will be another national service register of the manpower of the Dominion, but if this is decided upon it will be compulsory national service.
