

## RELEASE MEN FROM JAILS FOR SERVICE

Under the Military Service act all men of military age, except aliens, are required to report. This includes inmates of jails and penitentiaries and permission has been given to the military authorities by the government to let these men out on parole and have them report for examination.

E. R. Chapman, registrar of M. D. 10, said yesterday that this order would have little effect in this district, as the jails in the province are practically empty. All told there were only about 12 inmates in the jails of Manitoba, nine of whom came under this order. Four of these were in the provincial jail and only one was confined at Morden. Brandon reported three inmates. One of these was a man 63 years of age, another an American subject 23 years of age, and the third was an Austrian. At Minnedosa four prisoners were reported, three Austrians and one German. At Portage la Prairie there were only two eligible English-speaking prisoners.
