

ORDERED INTERNED

Three Members of Comedy Company Arrested at Toronto.

WINDSOR, Ont., Jan. 22.—Three members of "Katinka," a musical comedy were ordered interned here today. They are Max Drosman, Hugo Zorning and William Fleck, formerly of the Kaiser's army and navy. Alphonse Bachelder manager of the company was fined \$500 and costs in police court for assisting the Germans into the Dominion. The theatrical troupe entered Canada on Jan. 6, according to Traveling Immigration Inspector David H. Reynolds Bachelder when passing inspection at Windsor signed a manifesto stating that all the members of the company were United States citizens. The men were arrested in Toronto Sunday night and brought here for trial.

A fine of \$200 was also placed on each of the enemy aliens.

The Germans were interned because the United States Immigration authorities at Detroit would not allow them to re-enter the country.
