

ARIZONA MEN ARRESTED

Aided Fugitive From Halifax Internment Camp

Phoenix, Ariz., February 6.—G. A. Streitz, vice-president of the National Bank of Arizona, and Richard Partham, wealthy business man of this city, and both American citizens, were taken into custody tonight by United States officers on the charge of aiding the escape of an interned enemy alien. It is charged that the men gave financial aid to a fugitive from an internment camp at Halifax, named Tritterman, who came here seeking employment, and who disappeared before officers arrived from Halifax.
