

ALL MUST WORK OR BE JAILED

Every Canadian Male Between 16 And 60
Required to Labor.

A FEW EXCEPTIONS MADE

BUT THE IDLE RICH ARE NOT
AMONG THESE.

Drastic Regulations Are Passed With
Regard to Quebec—The Habeas
Corpus Law Is Suspended.

Ottawa, April 6.—The Order-in-Council dealing with aliens was laid on the table of the House of Commons yesterday afternoon by Sir Robert Borden. The order provides that every male person residing in Canada between the ages of sixteen and sixty must be regularly employed in some useful occupation. Exception is made for students, men temporarily unemployed owing to differences with their employers, those physically unfit and those unable to obtain work within a reasonable distance. There is a penalty of one hundred dollars and costs or imprisonment with hard labor for six months.
