ALIENS FOR ROAD WORK

Ontario Motorists' Suggestion re Interned Enemies

Ottawa, April 18.—At a joint meeting of representatives of the Ontario Motor League and the Ottawa Motor Club, in Ottawa this morning, the question of having aliens, now in the internment camps of Canada, employed on the highways of Canada, was discussed, and the sentiment of the members was that the scheme could be operated by having these men work in gangs and watched by returned soldiers.

The motorists intend to interview the Great War Veterans' Association, and it is probable that a joint delegation of the Great War Veterans and the motorists will wait upon the Government to request action in regard to this matter.
