

EMPIRE SONS URGE ALIEN

LABOR BE CONSCRIPTED

MONTREAL, May 29—That alien enemy labor should be utilized and that naturalization should be conferred on all alien enemies in the country, was the idea expressed Tuesday night at a meeting of the Imperial Order Sons of the Empire, held in the Windsor hotel. It was contended that they should be made British subjects under the old law, and that either by conscription or otherwise their labor should be employed for the good of the country. It was decided by a resolution to carry on a campaign, in co-operation with other societies throughout the dominion, for the employment of alien labor on the farms in Canada in the same manner as in Great Britain.
