

ANOTHER HUN FINED \$1,000 FOR SEDITION

Austrian Convicted of Boasting
Germans Will "Shoot Cana-
dians Like Dogs"

MACDONALD GIVES WARNING

The second \$1,000 dollar fine to be imposed on Winnipeg Huns in two days was meted out to Nick Kostenuick, Austrian, living at 255 Austin st., by Magistrate MacDonald in city police court today. He was given the option of serving one year in prison.

"When the Germans come to Canada they will shoot you like dogs," is the seditious utterance Kon Kostenuick was convicted of making.

Magistrate Macdonald declared that this was the last fine he would impose for an offense of this nature. "In future all offenders will be sent to prison for a term not to exceed seven years," he declared.

Three returned soldiers were the principal witnesses against Kostenuick. They declared on oath that the Austrian uttered the seditious statement in their presence June 6, in front of the Russian Orthodox church, Manitoba ave.

The prosecuting attorney, upon proving that the witnesses called by Kostenuick had been born in Austria, urged that their evidence be thrown out, as he believed that their stories were pre-arranged.

Kostenuick applied for trial by the court of appeals after the sentence had been imposed and was allowed release from custody upon furnishing \$2,000 bail.

Nick Balan, who was convicted and fined \$1,000 Thursday for making a similar statement the same morning at the same church, is to be released on \$2,000 bail. He also will appeal.
