AVOID ACTION ON ALIENS Aldermen Leave the Troublesome Issue to the Board of

Control. Ald. Brook Sykes' motion to compel Toronto shopkeepers to put in their windows a card which states whether they are aliens or British

subjects was shoved over to the door of the Board of Control by the Civić Legislation Committee. The aldermen decided that as no

legislation was needed to order the use of the cards, it was not a proper matter for their action.

Ald. Sykes alleged that some aliens

were taking out licenses under firm names, instead of using their own

individual names.
