

# **STILL REGARD BULGARIANS IN CANADA ALIEN ENEMIES**

**Must Report Movements to Police, Statement of Sir Percy  
Sherwood and Chief Ross.**

Citizens of Bulgaria residing in Canada will still be regarded as alien enemies by both the Dominion Police and the City Police and will continue to be regarded as such until some order is issued by the Government classing them otherwise, notwithstanding the fact that the Allies are no longer fighting Bulgaria. Newspaper accounts of the secession of Bulgaria from the Central Powers are not acceptable to Col. Sir Percy Sherwood, Chief Commissioner of the Dominion Police, or Chief Ross of the city police as official notice to regard Bulgarians living in this country as other than alien enemies.

"There are not many of them in the country," Col. Sherwood stated, "and this situation is not liable to cause any great difficulty. All citizens of Bulgaria residing in Canada are registered as alien enemies, and until an order comes from the Government they will still be obliged to report regularly to the chief of police, as required under the order-in-council governing alien enemies in Canada."

Chief Ross stated that Bulgars desiring to leave the city or on arriving in the city would have to report to the chief of police and have their papers signed, just as they and all other registered alien enemies have been doing since the order-in-council was passed.
