Secret Service Men Discover Well Organized Propaganda to Sow Seeds of Red Ruin in Canada.

## FOREIGNERS MASQUERADE AS SOCIAL-DEMOCRATS

## Scope of Dominion Police May be Increased to Deal With Situation. (World's Special Service.) OTTAWA, Nov. 14-Discovery by

secret service men that an extensive and well organized Bolshevik propaganda is being carried on in Canada, mostly among foreigners, and during the past year it has made startling progress, has led to consideration here of the establishment of effective Dominion machinery to enforce federal laws and preserve public safety.

During the past six months, Government agents have discovered that certain anarchistic foreigners. masquerading as the Social Democratic party and camouflaging their real purpose with a politico-economic platform, have been printing and cir-sulating literature of the most seditious, criminal and revolutionary character. A great deal of this literature has

a consequence, Bolshevik printing presses in Toronto and Montreal have been seized. Despite this vigilance, however, as many as eighteen branches of the Social Democratic party have been formed during the past year, mostly among Russians, Finns and Ukrainians. In Winnipeg it was discovered that certain Russians and Finns had formed a regular Soviet committee.

Must Prepare for Hard Times To deal with the menace, which

the authorities believe threatens the

very basis of Canada's social and political existence, it has been suggested that the present Dominion police be greatly enlarged, that the Dominion be partitioned into nine districts, each district in charge of a commissioner of police who would have under him three inspectors and an adequate number of men to enforce federal regulations looking to a preservation of law and order. It is felt that in the coming year or

two, when employment is likely to be scarce, and a field created for agitation and revolutionary propaganda, the need will be great for firm measures to guard the public safety. Government action along the lines in-

dicated may be expected shortly.
