

# MANY ITALIANS ARE GOING HOME

## FREEDOM OF PASSAGE ACROSS BOUNDARY—ALIEN ENEMIES MUST NOT LEAVE.

Niagara Falls, Ont., Nov. 25.—

Many of the Italians and other foreign-born men are passing through Niagara Falls on their way back to their homeland. Many of these men freely tell immigration officials here that they are going back just because the war is over and peace is again in Europe. Many of them are of military age, but they say Italy has pardoned all her citizens who failed to respond to the call to arms. Eighteen Italians went through here last night on their way to Italy. All restrictions are off at the bridges here, and men are allowed to pass freely. Immigration officers here were notified by Ottawa not to enforce the rule as to passports. The only restrictions now on are against alien enemies leaving Canada. For the meantime, Ottawa says, these men must be held in Canada. The United States continues to charge \$8 to anyone going across the line to work.
