

CANADA'S DELEGATES FROM WHOLE PEOPLE

NO SPECIAL REPRESENTATIVES FROM SEPARATE RACES CAN BE ACCREDITED.

(Canadian Press Despatch.)

Ottawa, Jan. 24.—There will be no Ukrainian delegates sent to the Peace Conference as the accredited representatives of the Dominion Government. The Dominion Government takes the view, it is understood, that it could not send representatives from Canada of any separate race or nationality. Any representatives fully accredited by the Canadian Government go as representing the Dominion as a whole. There is, however, no objection to **Ukrainians** in Canada sending their special representatives overseas if they wish, but such representatives will go as private citizens and not as delegates specially accredited by the Canadian Government.

A delegation from the Ukrainian-Canadian Citizens' League, Winnipeg, arrived in Ottawa a few days ago with a view to having Ukrainian representatives sent to Paris to assist in an advisory capacity. The delegation consisted of Taras Ferley, M.P.P. for Gimli, Man., and J. Megas, President of the Ukrainian Educational Institute, Saskatoon.

Bolsheviki Are Plotting Movement in South Africa

Johannesburg, S. A., Jan. 24.—A plan by certain persons to establish a Bolshevist movement on the Rand has been unmasked. The principals call themselves International Socialists, and the movement was inaugurated at the time of the armistice celebration. A circular was issued announcing that progress in practical arrangements was complete with "brothers in Russia."

Investigations show that the natives will have nothing to do with this Bolshevism, the native strike fiasco last June having discounted the International Socialists in the native mind. While not interfering with free speech, steps are being taken to insure adequate public protection.
