

TWELVE CARS DERAILED WHEN TRAIN JUMPS TRACK

North Bay, Ont., Jan. 27.—The Temiskaming and Northern national express number nine, which left Toronto on Saturday night, was derailed near Matheson, Ont., on Sunday night, owing, it is thought, to a broken rail. Twelve cars left the track but no one was injured. The private car of General Manager Hinton of the Grand Trunk Pacific was attached to the train, also special cars containing a number of German prisoners en route to Kapuscaasing internment camp.
