

Victoria May Ban All Meetings of Bolshevists

Victoria, B.C., Jan. 30.—Condemnation of Bolshevism and the necessity of suppressing its propaganda in this city is voiced in a resolution which Ald. J. Patrick will bring up before the city council on Monday.

The resolution asks the council to express an opinion that it is the duty of the authorities to prevent public

meetings which encourage 'sedition and discontent.

It also urges the government to deport all enemy aliens and to eliminate Bolshevism propaganda from Canada and henceforth to promote 'unity'. The meetings referred to in the resolution are those held under the 'auspices' of the federated labor party.
