CANADIAN IDEALS ARE COM-MUNICATED TO FOREIGN BORN. Winnipeg, Man., Jan. 31.-A Canadian viewpoint and Canadian ideals are being communicated to the foreign born people of Manitoba by the teachers through the children, declared Hon. Mr. Thornton, minister of education, in the legislature yesterday afternoon. "We do not wish anyone to come into this country," he said, "to make Canada his home unless he comes with the right spirit and intends to become 100 per cent Canadian. No one should get the rights and privileges of citizenship unless he is willing to accept the full burdens and duties that go with them." Lieut. J. W. Wilton called attention to a news Item, which he said he could not believe was true, that the German language is being used in certain schools in the province. Dr. Thornton denied that German was being taught in any of the public schools with the knowledge and consent of the department. If any unauthorized text books are being used the matter will be dealt with thoroughly and promptly. In addition to debate on the address a number of bills were ad-

vanced to a second reading stage.
