Talking to a returned soldier after the raid on some business premises and clubs, he said:—"The government is to blame for this. What have they been doing to allow aliens to demand 40 cents an hour and us lighting for a \$1.10 a day? Why didn't they intern them?"

We agree with him

and we not only agree with him now but, unlike other employers, we showed our hatred of the Alien in a practical manner.

We were compelled to engage alien labor to unload iron at our siding and we paid 30 cents an hour. After working a few days they asked for 35 cents an hour.

Did they get it?

Not on your life!

What they did get?

Fired on the spot and when they came for their pay (10 days) got nothing and they have not got it yet. (This was June, 1918).

What we did

Closed our siding and sold the iron as we got it, losing hundreds of dollars.

What some of our competitors did

Engaged the aliens that we fired and paid them what they asked.

We do not employ alien labor

and if the help we hire is not satisfactory to the returned boys
