## SEDITION CASE WITNESS IS BORN IN CANADA BUT CANNOT SPEAK ENGLISH

When Joseph Goloski was called to give evidence in the Korda sedition case in assize court today he swore that he could not speak the English language and asked for an interpreter.

Judge Curran questioned him because of his youthful appearance and found that Goloski, was 17 years old, was born in Maniloba 20 miles from Winnipeg and had attended public school at Brokenhead more than three years.

"This is a sad state of affairs," the judge commented. "It is certainly not a compliment to the present system of education in Canada."

Goloski then volunteered incoherently that he had also been under the teaching of an English-speaking school master.
