

JUST INTERN ALIENS TILL PEACE IS SIGNED

The alien question will be again discussed by the Cabinet Council to-day. General deportation of alien enemies at the present time is utterly impossible owing to the transportation situation and the difficulties of returning citizens of enemy countries until after peace is signed.

What is now proposed is that there should be an enlargement of internment and that undesirable or dangerous aliens should be interned in the various prison camps until after peace is declared, when they could be deported.

It is proposed that the County Court judges should act as tribunals to decide what aliens are undesirable and should be deported. Another suggestion is that city councils in large cities should have authority to appoint committees to assist the judges before whom all aliens would have to report.
