

Modify Restrictions on Licenses for Aliens

Toronto, Feb. 18.--Owing to protests received from foreign countries, the board of license commissioners decided to modify their restrictions made a few weeks ago regarding issuing licenses to aliens.

The commissioners decision was "that all British born and naturalized subjects be issued licenses and that licenses be issued to such aliens who are not enemy aliens and who may be considered desirable."

The right of the police to search the baggage of citizens at the railway stations for liquor, which has caused such a storm of protests, was discussed and the matter was referred to the city solicitor for a decision.
