

# *Has No Fear of Bolshevism Here*

*Veterans Much Opposed to It,  
Says H. J. Daly.*

"It isn't a case of going back to normal" said H. J. Daly, Director of Repatriation, in discussing post-war conditions with the Star. "There will be no more normal as we knew it before the war. It is a case now of adjusting ourselves to new conditions."

Mr. Daly doesn't fear Bolshevism in Canada. "The most encouraging part of it," he remarked, "is that the veterans are very much opposed to it and will oppose it in any shape or form."

Since he became Director of Repatriation, Mr. Daly has held literally hundreds of co-ordinating conferences with employers and employed, returned soldiers and social workers. He said, that, "what we need, I think, is close co-operation between all classes and mutual understanding. But all are very anxious and willing to help. It is just a case of bringing them together."
