

TORONTO HOLDING BOLSHEVISTS OF DANGEROUS TYPE

One Accused of Sending Information to Germany During War

Toronto, April 29.—Sensational disclosures were made last night by the local police, the Canadian Immigration authorities, the provincial authorities and Albert J. Cawdron, acting chief commissioner of the Dominion police, Ottawa, in respect to the Bolshevick and revolutionary activities of Lieb Samsonavitch, alias Samson Black, and Charlie Arthur Ewart, alias Arthur Ewi' and Lita Zaborowski, alias Annie Bancourt, A. E. Brown and Mrs. Ewit, who are now in custody, awaiting deportation. According to the authorities aforementioned Ewart and the Zaborowski woman are native Germans, and Ewart has been besides a revolutionary propagandist a surreptitious communicator of valuable information to Germany during the war. The evidence gained, by the police and other workers, proves those arrested to be firebrands of the worst type; also that Toronto itself is impregnated with the Bolshevick element.
