Alien Board To Summons Budka

ARCHBISHOP IS TO APPEAR NEXT MONDAY

Huge Volume of Evidence is Said to Have Been Prepared By Investigators

19 OTHERS NAMED

Archbishop Budka is to be summonsed to appear before the Alien Investigation board Monday to show cause why he should not be deported from Canada as an undesirable, it was announced today.

Officials of the board asserted that they had more than 100 pages of typewritten evidence

in the case.

Veterans Are Active

The archbishop, who is head of the Greek Orthodox church of western Canada, has been in the limelight several times since the war started because of circulars and pastoral letters he caused to be distributed.

At the outbreak of the war he was accused of issuing a letter urging all Austrians to return home and fight for their native country.

It is known that members and officials of the Great War Veterans' association have been active recently in getting the matter before the allenboard.

There are said to be 19 persons, in addition to the archbishop, named in the evidence as having given aid to Dudka. It is considered probably that they also will be summonsed by the board.
