SAYS SIR JAMES AITKENS EMPLOYS GERMAN GARDENER

Lieutenant - Governor of Manitoba Charged With Hiring Alien Help. Veterans Denounce Bolshevists.

WINNIPEG, May 12.—A crowd of 1,000 persons attended an open air meeting of returned soldiers held in the market square Saturday afternoon.

Capt. J. F. Wheeler mentioned, in

the course of his speech, that aliens were hired by a certain man high in government circles. The crowd demanded the official's name. Capt. Wheeler replied that he was not afraid of any man. He said it was Sir James Aitkens, the lieutenant-governor. His information was first hand. He declared that a Chinese cook, a German gardener and one other alien was employed by the lieutenant-governor.

The speakers denounced the Bolshevists, placing them on the same plane as the alien enemy.
