12 ALIENS ARE TO BE DEPORTED

Deportation of 12 of the 28 enemy aliens arrested by police during the riot a week ago, has been ordered by the board of federal immigration officials investigating their cases. Hugh Phillipps, K.C., special prosecutor, announced in police court this afternoon.

The men were sent to Kapuskasing internment camp, Ont., early this morning, where they will be held pending arrangements for transportation.

Investigation in the cases of the 16 other aliens has been ordered by the board, according to Assistant Crown Prosecutor J. Thorson. The men were formally arraigned in police court this afternoon and remanded for a week.

Mr. Thorson issued the following list of names of the men to be deported: Harry Kirzizinski, Sam Baran, Peter Misler, John Melenski, Sam Okranicz, Steve Pricun, Tom Forman, Peter Kupszuk, E. Skaz, Joe Sekerka, John Jaremkicwicz, Alfred Adam.

Fifteen other aliens arrested in the riot were granted remands to consult with their counsel.

Ten men arrested near the Crescent Creamery plant two weeks ago for alleged intimidation, were to appear for preliminary trial this afternoon.
