

SIXTY MEN PLACED IN POSITIONS HERE DURING LAST WEEK

Local Gov't Bureau Asked About Men for Mounted Police

Sixty men were placed in position last week through Mr. Neil McDougall at the Ontario Government Employment Bureau, a number of them going to the Rand Consolidated at Goudreau and others to the Hope Lumber Co. at Mile 28 on the A. C. R. This latter Company is looking for all the men it can secure. Mr. McDougall reports that there is plenty of work, and that it is sometimes difficult to secure men to fill the requests for labor.

He has been instructed to recruit men for the R. N. W. P., and would be glad to discuss the matter with those who desire to enter the force.

There is a constant demand for housemaids, and hotel help. During the week a number of girls have been placed in good positions in private homes in the city.

Mr. Bert Holgate, in charge of the Soldiers Civil Re-Establishment Office, placed twelve returned men in positions during the week.
