Britain to Restrict Alien Employment

Canadian Press Despatch. London, July 10.—Despite strong oposition by the Government House

of Commons, a committee to-day passed, by a vote of 15 to 12, a clause in the Alien Bill restricting the employment of aliens in Great Britain. Office had argued in committee that inclusion of the clause in the bill would wreck the influence of the

country in the Empire.
