

SENDING MAIL TO HUNS

Department Cleaning Up War Accumulations.

Ottawa, July 23.—Canada's mail service has been resumed with Germany, as Great Britain is now exporting to a certain extent into Germany, and as it has been practically decided here that Canada will follow automatically all the moves of the United Kingdom towards a resumption of trade, it may be said that Canada has also resumed trade relations. It is not yet certain whether another order-in-Council may be necessary to make sure, but this matter is now under consideration by the Department of Justice.

Since the allied blockade was raised, no applications have been made for licenses to export to Germany from Canada, although the German prisoners of war and interned civilians who are being sent back tomorrow have asked for permission to take goods with them.
