Cobalt, July 36.—At a meeting of the returned soliders or the district held in the town half-here yesterday a committee to wiit upon the mine. Managers' Association and the miner, union was appointed in an effort to obtain some basis for the settlement of the present strike here. V.A. that the mine managers had agreed to this concession asked for by the Veterans. There have been no other developments in the local situation.
