

# MATHERS QUASHES HABEAS CORPUS PROCEEDINGS FOR RELEASE OF S. P. ALMAZOFF

Habeas corpus proceedings under which the defense sought to obtain bail for Solomon Pearl Almazoff, one of the four men of foreign birth held by the immigration authorities, were quashed by Chief Justice Mathers in a decision this morning.

The Almazoff case was brought in the hope of obtaining bail for all four men now held at immigration hall.

Court action in the case of Oscar Schoppelrei, whose deportation was ordered some time ago by the special board of inquiry and was stayed pending the decision of the court, is still before the court of appeals. In this case the defense has attempted to quash the proceedings of the special board entirely.
