

BISHOP BUDKA IS ACQUITTED OF CHARGE

WINNIPEG, Nov. 26.—An acquittal on the charges laid against Bishop Budka by the Great War Veterans' association was handed down today by Judge Paterson in the Court of King's Bench. The charge was alleged failure to report as an enemy alien, and the judge held that the bishop did not have to report, Col. Lindsay, the registrar of enemy aliens, having excused him. The decision was reserved at the hearing two weeks ago.
