

Dr. E. Kohlman Taken to Fort Henry

Dr. Erwin Kohlmann, formerly water expert in the Works Department at the City Hall, who resigned a few weeks ago after an agitation arising out of his alleged pro-German views, was taken last night to the **detention** camp at Fort Henry, near Kingston. There were also three Austrians in the party. They were in charge of Lieut. Stagg and a guard from Kingston.

When seen at the Union Station before the departure of the train Dr. Kohlmann declined to make a statement.

"I have positively nothing to say for publication," said Dr. Kohlmann "I have very great objections to being interviewed."

Two coaches filled with Austrian prisoners of war arrived last night from the **detention** camp at Fort Henry en route to Hearst.
