

# ELEVEN MEN ARRESTED

Believed to be All But One of  
Escaped German Prisoners.

ST. JOHN, Jan. — Eleven men believed to be part of the contingent of twelve Germans who yesterday tunneled their way to liberty out of the internment camp at Amherst N. S., have been taken into custody. Eight were arrested at St. Stephen, and three were at McAdams, N. B. The suspects are apparently of foreign extraction and had travelled on short ride railway tickets from one small place to another and were making for the International Boundary. The men were headed by Gustav Hartwig, who is looked upon by the authorities as a particularly dangerous German spy.
