

# HUN OFFICERS BOWED AS THE DUKE PASSED

Governor-General Spent Some  
Time in Internment Camp Chat-

Halifax, N.S., August 24.—An interesting episode in the visit of the Governor-General to Halifax occurred yesterday when His Royal Highness was in the citadel. Interned there are about three hundred German prisoners, all officers, the rank and file being in the detention camp in much greater numbers at Amherst. The Duke was escorted into the enclosure where the prisoners are kept at the citadel, and was introduced to the officer who is looked upon as their leader.
